

Fall 2018 Studio Tuition:

Fall Semester begins August 27 and ends December 17.

Most lessons are a private 30-minute, 45 minute or 60 minute weekly session.

Fall Tuition for 30 minute private lessons is \$400 which can be paid in advance or by the 1st of each month , \$100 monthly installments September through December.

Advanced Sessions (weekdays): \$600/45 minute lessons weekly \$800/60 minute lessons weekly.

Fall Registration fee is \$15.

Sunday Pricing:

Sunday lessons are a la carte. Sunday has become a tradition at our studio. We offer sessions with Craig Cameron, Alexandria Bagwell and Isaac Morris. We put this schedule together each weekend to help give flexibility to those who cannot fit weekly lessons into their busy schedules.

Sunday students have a registration fee of \$15 to be included in the “rotation”.

Sunday Fee Schedule: (PAY YOUR INSTRUCTOR)

\$25/30 minute session

\$50/60 minute session (as available)

Ukulele class: \$150 FALL SEMESTER - Wednesdays at 6:00

Junior Singers: \$150 FALL SEMESTER – Wednesdays at 5:30

Show Choir: \$150 FALL SEMESTER - Sundays at 3:30

Ensemble Pricing:

This is payable by the first of each month, September-December. There will be no credits or refunds issued for attendance issues. There will be a minimum of 10 classes each semester in preparation for the holiday performance. (and other performance opportunities as they arise).

Studio Policies:

Missed Lessons: There will be NO credit or make-up lessons for missed lessons that occur with less than 24 hours notice. Each student may have ONE excused absence per semester in which a make up session will be offered with one of our instructors on a Friday/Saturday or Sunday. In October and November we will designate a weekend for make-up session scheduling. You are NOT guaranteed a specific instructor for this make-up session.

Of course, if the staff member must cancel the lesson and another staff member cannot sub or reschedule, then we will make a proper credit to your account. These sessions will also be offered as make up sessions on the October/November designated make up weekends.

Materials: Materials fees will be added as needed to cover piano books, tracks, sheet music, digital music, apps needed, etc. When appropriate we will pre-approve this with the parent.

I-pads are recommended for piano lessons. We are a bronze award-winning studio for integrating technology into lessons using the Piano Maestro application (which only runs on ipad). This is included for NO CHARGE to students who are active on our roster.

Recital: We offer several performance opportunities during the Fall and Spring semester. We have an annual Christmas party which normally includes students playing/singing holiday selections in an informal environment.

Practice Routine: Students will have varying practice times according to their age and level (and of course dedication to the art). It is necessary that students who sign up for 30 minute lessons attend at least 1 Friday session per month (and can come every week) for guided practice with Heather Hlley. Heather will also be on site to help them with Music Theory. Students may also come and use our studio ipads for Piano Maestro time on one of our studio instruments. You must let Heather know if you're coming and what time frame you will arrive between 3:30-6 PM each Friday.

Alexandria Bagwell will also be available on Sundays from 3-5 for guided practice for piano/voice. You MUST message us and let us know you're coming or call the day of and see if there's available time.

Instruments:

It is important to have a quality instrument to practice on.

For voice students, it is important to have access to an ipad or iphone/ipod to record vocal exercises and access digital music we suggest or provide. A Bluetooth speaker may also be helpful as all of our lessons have technology integrated.

For piano students: We suggest a full size instrument (88 keys). Electric instruments are great as long as the quality is good. Weighted or hammer action keys is recommended as the student progresses. Full size keys are absolutely necessary.

For guitar students: Craig Cameron will make suggestions as to the size and shape of instrument that works best with your build and also your budget and goals. Many of our students take lessons on electric guitars and acoustic/electric or classical instruments.

For Ukulele class or private lessons: You must provide your own instrument. The studio has a few that can be used on site for practice or if you forget your instrument and have class that day. An ipad or ipod is also a great resource for this as an app for tuning is necessary.

Studio instruments:

Studio pianos are available during guided practice sessions on Wednesday, Friday and Sunday. Please see Heather Hiley or Heather Van Wieren to make sure you're on the schedule for private practice time or guided practice. This is a service we offer with your tuition. Permission for private practice can be REVOKED if a student is not respectful of the studio property or space.
